


C. Chairs Report

- Ms. Rongen and Ms. Busch attended the Thurston County Sex Offender multi-disciplinary group which includes law enforcement and treatment providers.
- Ms. Rongen and Ms. Balmert attended the Washington Association for Treatment of Sexual Abusers (WATSA) where they saw a presentation of Word Watch. The Court Watch Program received a grant for their Word Watch Program. This program monitors the use of language in court and in court documents. Volunteers read documents and attend court proceedings to look for words that victim blame, minimize and imply consent language.
- **Juvenile Board Cases** – We now have six offenders released in the community under the “Miller Fix” legislation. Since it is such a unique population, we have discovered some computer glitches that we are working to get fixed and Ms. Rongen has brought these issues to the attention of the Assistant Secretary of the Community Corrections Division.


